



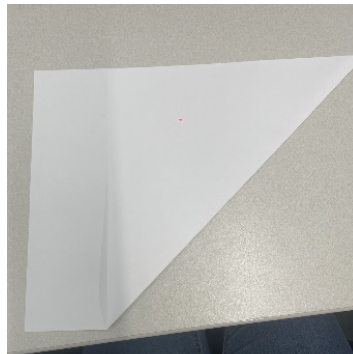
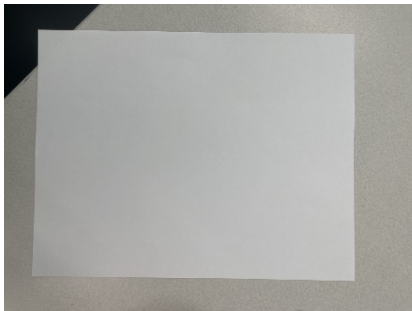
Paper Snowflakes

Materials needed:

- String and clothes pins (optional: if desired to hang on)

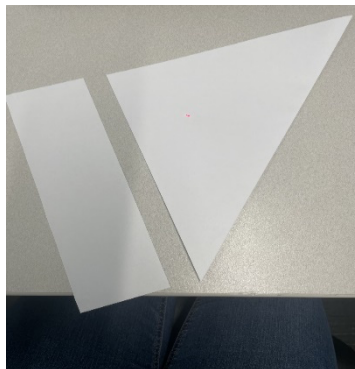
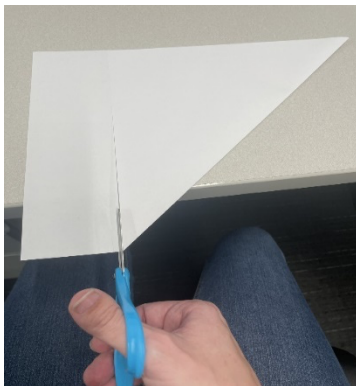
Directions

- 1. Have a discussion with your child about how snow is formed**
 - a. Here are a couple of books you can check out:
 - i. Today is a Snowy Day by Martha E.H. Rustad
 - ii. Snowflakes by Martha E.H. Rustad
- 2. Grab a piece of 8.5 x 11 paper and fold diagonally**



- 3. Cut off strip at bottom**

- a. Scissor cutting is a ready for kindergarten skill, do not expect it to be perfect, your child is learning!

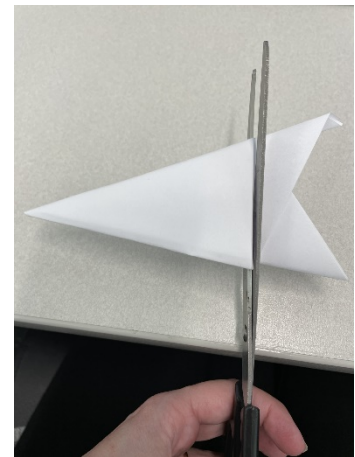
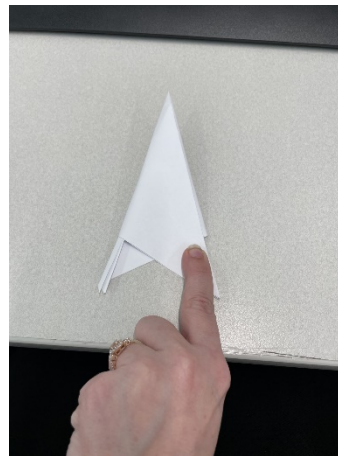
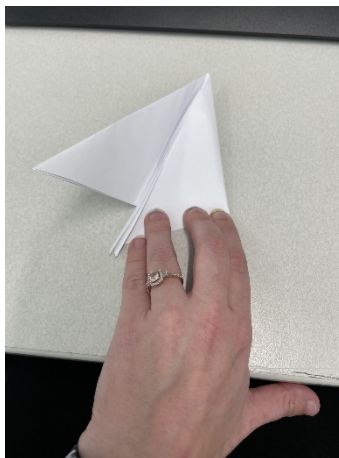




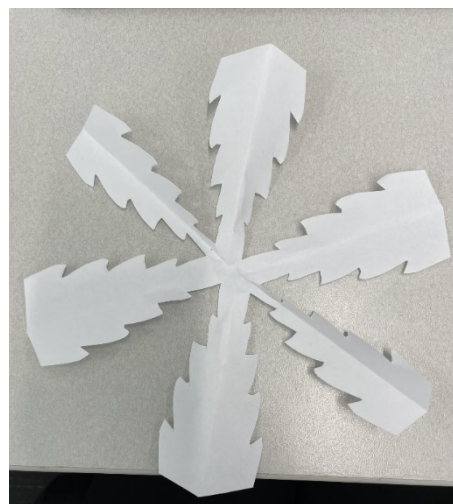
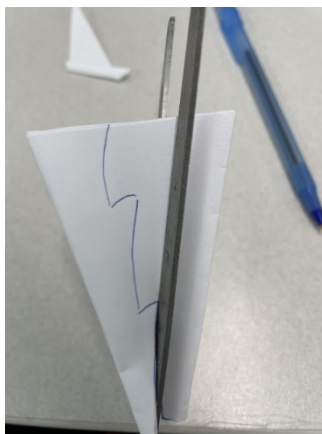
4. Fold triangle in half



5. Fold new triangle into thirds and cut off tails



6. Draw and cut out design of choice, unfold to see final result
